DIFFERENCES IN THE COMPETITION RULES BETWEEN ECA AND ICF CHAMPIONSHIPS- WILDWATER CANOEING

Dear friends in sport,

I kindly ask to make positive decision for changes between ECA and ICF Rules followed in this document.

GENERAL:

- To be recognised as the European Championships minimum of 5 National teams must start at each event.
- Jury consists of 3 persons: President and 2 members
- The ECA Jury members and the ECA technical delegate must have their travel and accommodation expenses paid by the organizers of the Championships. The second member will be from the organizing Federation. The ECA Jury members will select the third member of the Jury from the people present at the event if one is not already allocated.
- Organizers need to organize and pay accommodation and meals for judges at the Championships

WILDWATER CANOEING:

- ECA WWC Championships for Senior`s will be held every year. Classic and sprint races together every odd year and sprint race every even year.
- Junior and U23 Championships will be organized together every even year.
- Classic and sprint Senior`s, Junior`s and U23 Championships should be organized during four days.
- Sprint Senior Championships should be organized during two days.
- Every Championships must have defined daily programme according to the disciplines. Only in exceptional circumstances, because of TV needs, the

programme can deviate from standardized programme, but it has to be harmonized with ECA until the end of November the year before the championships.

- In all the other cases when ECA rules differences are not defined, ICF Rules for World Championships (Senior or Junior and U23) apply at ECA European Championships.
- Costs of TVS and judges accommodation are part of the contract between ECA and OC and can be included in the accreditation fee.
